Donald Edward Savill, better known to his amateur radio friends as KE7JNB, became a silent key on Wednesday, March 7, 2017. In addition to being a past Secretary of CARA, Don was a regular net control station on the Thursday evening Mule Mountain FM net until about two years ago. He was also a member of the Arizona Traffic and Emergency and Maritime Service HF nets. His always-friendly voice will be sadly missed by all club members.

Don was born in Toronto, Ontario Canada on Nov. 11, 1939, to the late Lucy and Edward Savill. He joined the U.S. Army in 1959 where he served as a radio operator until 1962.
